## Parent Information

### Student Eligibility

We are committed to providing a strong foundation for our youngest learners to build their future. If your child will turn 5 by August 31, 2024, they are eligible for enrollment in Excel Christian Academy for the 2024-2025 school year.

### School Calendar

Excel Christian Academy will follow the local school district school calendar, starting school on August 26, 2024, and ending school on June 6, 2025. Our school year has a total of 180 days.

#### **Required Documents**

#### **Documentation of Age**

A birth certificate or alternative document(s) of birth is/are required The child must be 5 years of age on or before August 31st of the year of school entry.

#### Immunization

The parent/guardian must provide verification of the child's immunizations. North Carolina state law requires the following minimum doses:

- **5 DPT doses -** 5th dose MUST be on or after the 4th birthday.
- **4 Polio doses** 4th dose to be given on or after the child's fourth birthday.
- 0 3-4 HIB doses at least 1 Hib on/after 1st birthday and before 5 years of age (Not required after age 5).
- 0 2 MMR doses 1st dose on/after 1st birthday and 2nd dose before enrolling in school for the first time.
- 3 Hepatitis B doses A series of 3 doses is required for all children born on or after July 1, 1994.
- 2 Varicella doses Vaccination is required unless documentation of disease history is provided by a healthcare provider.
- 4 Pneumococcal conjugate doses (Not required after age 5).

Be sure your child's name/birthdate, doctor's stamp or signature, and the month, day, and year of each immunization are on the record.

### Communications

Excel Christian Academy utilizes important phone calls, emails, and text messages relayed through the MadMimi communication system. Having accurate cell phone and email addresses on file is very important.

### Nutrition

Students will be served a hot, healthy lunch and afternoon snacks. School menus will list on the school website.

### Curriculum

We will use the GREAT MINDS curriculum (Standard Course of Study).

Course	Description
Wit & Wisdom - English Language Arts	The ELA approach used by Wit & Wisdom enables students to improve their skills and knowledge with every lesson. Reading, Writing, Foundational Skills (Book & Print Awareness, Handwriting, Phonics, Phonemic Awareness), Language, Speaking and Listening. Literacy Block: Our comprehensive approach includes whole and small-group sessions totaling 2.5 hours daily. This balanced approach covers phonemic awareness, phonics comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary instruction, ensuring a well-rounded literacy education.
Eureka Math	The Mathematics Block, a key component of our curriculum, is structured into whole- group and small-group sessions. It is allocated one hour per day and strongly emphasizes developing students' number sense, a fundamental aspect of mathematical understanding.
Social Studies	Thematic Units: Integration of Social Studies and Leadership content.
PhD Science	The PhD Science program is designed to help students move from simply reading about science to actively engaging in scientific inquiry. Students gain a better understanding of scientific concepts through a learning cycle that involves asking questions, investigating phenomena, developing evidence-based explanations, and applying new knowledge to explain additional phenomena. This program emphasizes hands-on engagement with the phenomena under investigation, allowing students to learn through experience.
Chapel	During chapel, students have the opportunity to pray, worship, and listen to Bible stories and object lessons. The atmosphere is lively and upbeat, and students can participate in games and lesson activities. The responsibilities of the chapel are shared by teachers, administrators, and church staff.
